Students receive instruction in the life-threatening dangers of HIV/AIDS, its transmission, and its prevention. 7 th Grade	-	Health
8 th Grade	-	Physical Education
9 th Grade	-	Physical Education
10 th Grade	-	Health
11 th Grade	-	US History
12 th Grade	-	Government

This education is provided by the King County Public Health's F.L.A.S.H. Curriculum (Family Life and Sexual Health). This curriculum is district approved, along with all the media that accompanies it.
