

Gearing Up for 2021-2022 Registration in February & March

The registration process for the 2021-2022 school year begins soon. Like the rest of our world, the virtual setting will create changes.

Students and families also have questions about how the pandemic repercussions will impact class choices.

We are still in the process of confirming those details, but here is what we know:

- The process will start 0-3 weeks after mid-winter break.
- It will begin with a virtual information session for students run by our counselors.
- Over the following week, short videos will be available on the school website to provide more about classes.
- If students have questions, a way to ask those questions most effectively is still under development.
- During this same time, either a recorded or live parent information session will be available, with directions on how to ask questions.

- To register for classes, students will need to fill out both the class selection in Synergy plus an electronic form that submits the information in a different way. Instructions to follow.

- Due dates for student course requests will likely be mid-March, with official dates to be communicated no-later than the information sessions.
