Policy	Rationale	Duration
1400 - Meeting Conduct, Order of Business, Quorum and Public Comment	Suspend the ten (10) minute time limit for public comment to allow for adjustments to public comment due to the transition to in-person/streamed regular School Board meetings	Until the policy revisions completed by the Governance, Oversight and Legislative Committee are adopted by the Board
2410 – Graduation Requirements	<p>Suspend the BSD additional graduation requirement that each student earn a minimum of forty (40) hours of community s service.</p> <p>Nearly all local organizations have suspended in-person volunteer opportunities.</p> <p>Virtual opportunities are available, though many students find additional hours spent on the computer to be detrimental to their overall well-being.</p> <p>Due to financial hardships associated with the pandemic, some students are working an increased number of hours to help support their families.</p> <p>The Class of 2021 was unable to complete community service hours last winter/spring as well as over the summer.</p>	2020-21 school year Reactivation Date: June 22, 2021
4200 – School Visitors	Consistent with the BSD Fall Reopening Plan, the school day will be limited to only emergency need or contracted agency staff that work directly with students for educational purposes (i.e. Community Care). Other (typically agency) staff will need to meet with students remotely.	2020-21 School year Reactivation Date: June 22, 2021

	No volunteer/PTSA/mentors, tutors, etc., will be allowed inside buildings during the school day (to include one half hour before and after school).	
5021 - Conflicts Between Policy and Bargaining Agreements	Suspending this policy allows the District and unions to address conflicts in a way that the bargaining agreements don't take precedence if there is a conflict between policy and the collective bargaining agreements or MOUs.	2020-21 school year Reactivation Date: June 22, 2021
5401 – Sick Leave and Attendance Program	<p>The Finance and Operations committee recommends suspension of the Sick Leave and Attendance Incentive Program because of potential adverse impacts on employees and students.</p> <p>Suspension of this policy allows the District to review its attendance incentive practices and how they may inadvertently impact the safety of employees and students in the workplace.</p>	2020-21 school year Reactivation Date: June 22, 2021
