# Decision Making Process

The culminating activity of the math adoption committee will be to reach a decision regarding which math program to recommend to the Instructional Materials Committee for adoption.

*We will be using the same process to select the 4 materials we want to examine further.*

- Each committee member has one vote that must be exercised.
- No abstentions will be allowed.
- A clear recommendation will be indicated by a super majority of >60%, 14 of 24, in favor of one of the materials.



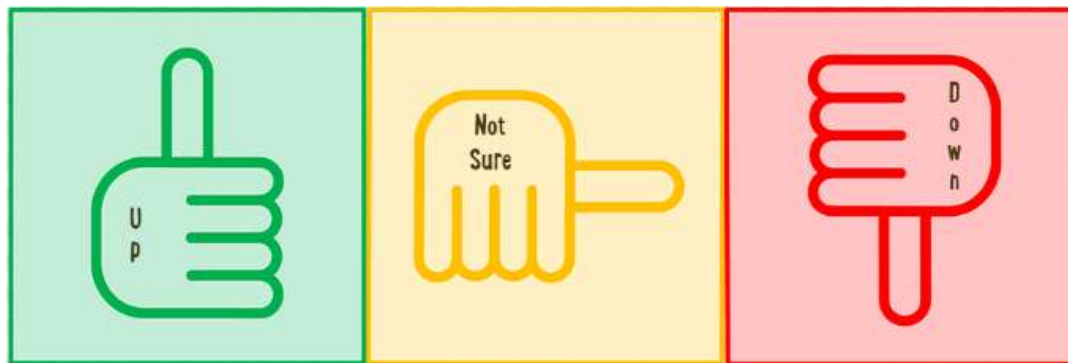
# Are we ready?

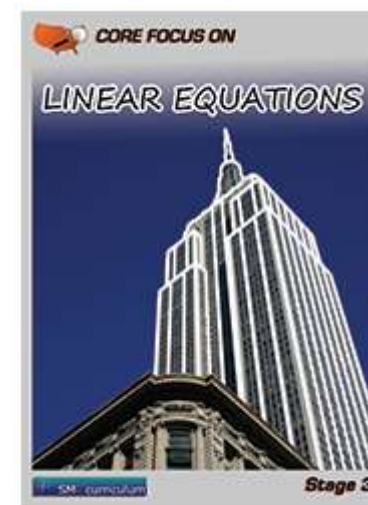
