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### Program Overview

*As a Bellevue College student, OLS students earn an accredited associate degree in Occupational & Life Skills. Students will spend 10-14 hours in the classroom weekly taking courses such as Personal Finance, Healthy Relationships, Writing & Media, Computer Applications, and Workplace Problem-Solving. Class sizes are small, with 12-16 students in each class, allowing for more personalized instruction. Students also complete a 200-hour internship with a local business, and Financial Aid is available for those who qualify.*
